

The teams will be collecting and analysing the livelihood challenges faced by various groups in their respective communities. An online bootcamp training will be conducted.

PHASE 2 CREATE SOLUTIONS

The teams will be creating (ideating) customised solution that can create income generation activities in the community

PHASE 3 CHANGE LIVES

The teams will implement selected solutions in their communities to make them 'Atmanirbhar'.

FINAL SHOWCASE

The teams will showcase their journey at the end of the challenge through an online final showcase.







