




6.1: Institutional Vision and Leadership


Implementation of National Education Policy

BA Program Course Structure under NEP-2020

The following are the various categories of courses suggested for the UG Programs.

- Major Courses (Core Course) In sem -1 paper 1,2; In sem-2 Paper 3,4; In sem-3 paper 5,6,7; In sem-4 paper 8,9,10; In sem-5 paper 11 to 13; In sem-6 paper 14 to 16.(Total 16 papers) Each paper/course credit is 4) Major (Core) Courses, has 12 subjects. These will be related to the subject of programme in which the candidate gets his/her final Graduation degree.
- Minor Course (Core Elective) In Sem -1 paper-1; In Sem-2 paper 2; In Sem-4 paper 3; In Sem-5 paper 4 & 5 and Sem-6 paper 6 (Total Paper 6) Each paper/course credit is 4, Minor (Core Elective) Course, has 12 subjects. Candidate has to choose except the major (core) subject.
- Multi-disciplinary Course (MDC) Course-I, II & III in Sem- I Course-I; Sem-II Course-II and Sem-III Course-III.
 - Candidate has to choose any one Subject compulsorily in 1st, 2nd & 3rd Semester from basket. In Sem.-1 & 2 Sanskrit/Prakrit/Persian/Home Science Education & Extension/ Elements of Statistics and other 12 Subjects From Minor's basket. In Sem.-3 Impact of literature on society and culture/History of major revolution/Population education /Principle of literary criticism etc.
- 4. Ability Enhancement Course-Modern Indian Languages: English/ Gujarati / Hindi etc. Among these one has to be studied compulsory in Sem-1 course-I, Sem-2 course II, in Sem-3 course-III and in Sem-4 course-IV, & Sem 6 Course-V Total paper 5. Each Paper credit is 2.
- Skill Enhancement Course- Language Communication Skill: English/Gujarati / Hindi etc. Among these one has to be studied compulsory in Sem-1 course-I and in Sem-2 course-II, in Sem-3 course III and in Sem-4 course IV and Sem-5 course-V, Total paper 5. Each Paper credit is 2.
- Value Added Courses: Indian Knowledge System (IKS) / Environmental Studies / Human rights and Duties / Family Studies / Impact of Modernization on Language & Literature of Gujarat (IMLL)), etc. In Sem-1, 2, 3 and 4 Choose any one in every Semester from basket. Each paper / Course credit is 2.
 - "In VAC student can select any ONE subject from the basket, but can't select the same subject in other Sems. For example if student select "Environment" in Sem-1, then he/she can't go for the same subject in Sem-II. He/She can select another paper of same subject i.e. environment-II.
 - As per University Circular No. S./paripatra/19618/2023, Dtd. 28/07/2023, Bharatiya Knowledge System – An Introduction is mandatory for all students in 1st Semester under VAC.
- 7. Other activity- Saptadhara Etc. Student may choose any one in each Semester.
- Proposed Vocational Courses: Computer Hardware & Software, translation, Business Mathematics, Yoga theory & Naturopathy, Computer Application, Computer Network Management, Web designing, Landscaping & gardening, House wiring & Electrical repairing, Tourism, Creative/Content writing, Personality Development
- 9. Student can pursue Honours program (fourth year) on successful completion of third year with 132 credit and internship in core discipline of 4 credits. The student securing the required number of credit at the end of four year along with 12 credits of research project/dissertation will be awarded with a degree of Honours with Research.
